The Delores Barr Weaver Policy Center is accepting nominations to award those who have gone above and beyond to champion the rights of girls and young women impacted by the justice system.

We encourage nominations of inspiring and dedicated individuals whose efforts have significantly advanced the rights and well-being of girls, young women, and those who identify as such, who are impacted by the justice system or who are at risk for justice-system involvement. We look forward to sharing their stories, acknowledging their accomplishments, and inspiring others who hear of their extraordinary efforts.

AWARD CATEGORIES

See the Girl Advocacy Award: This award recognizes advocacy and activism as one of the most important and effective strategies for systemic change. Types of advocacy and activism work honored in this category include system change, legislative action, civic engagement, grassroots advocacy, or individual advocacy that has positively impacted the life or lives of justice-system involved girls and young women.

See the Girl Direct Service Award: This award recognizes an individual who embodies girl-centered principles and who partners with girls and young women to provide exemplary service.

See the Girl Leadership Award: This award recognizes a girl or young woman whose efforts champion social justice and systemic change for girls in her school, community, or state.

Legislator of the Year Award: This award recognizes a public official who has provided leadership leading to systemic changes to positively impact girls and young women affected by the justice system.

Joan Amery Van Vleck Research Award: Named in honor of Joan Amery Van Vleck who champions research and is devoted to improving the lives of women and girls, this award recognizes an individual in the field of justice, child welfare, education, or a related field who has made noteworthy contributions to the body of knowledge about the experiences of girls and young women impacted by the justice system.

The Delores Barr Weaver, See the Girl Lifetime Achievement Award: Named in honor of Delores Barr Weaver, a lifelong advocate and champion of girls and young women, this award celebrates those individuals whose many years of dedication have led to significant contributions that level the playing field and increase opportunities for girls and young women impacted by the justice system.

Eligibility

- Anyone in the United States who fits the criteria in the award description for which they are nominated.
- Individuals may only be nominated for one award category.
- One individual for each category will be recognized at the See the Girl Awards.



Nomination Process and Deadline

- All nominations must be received by Tuesday, August 15, 2017, 5pm.
- Winners and nominators will be notified by email on Wednesday, August 30, 2017.
- Winners are expected to attend the See the Girl Awards luncheon.
- Winners will receive an additional invitation for a guest of their choosing.
- Winners travelling from outside Northeast Florida will be provided a traveling stipend.
- Your entry acknowledges permission for the Policy Center to access and share information and materials collected from the nomination on its website, communications, and social media.
- All nominations will be evaluated by a selection committee that includes members of the Justice for Girls Leadership Council, Girls' Leadership Council, and the board of directors of the Policy Center.
- The submission must include the completed nomination form. Additional letters of support may be included with the nomination and do not count toward the 1000 word limit.
