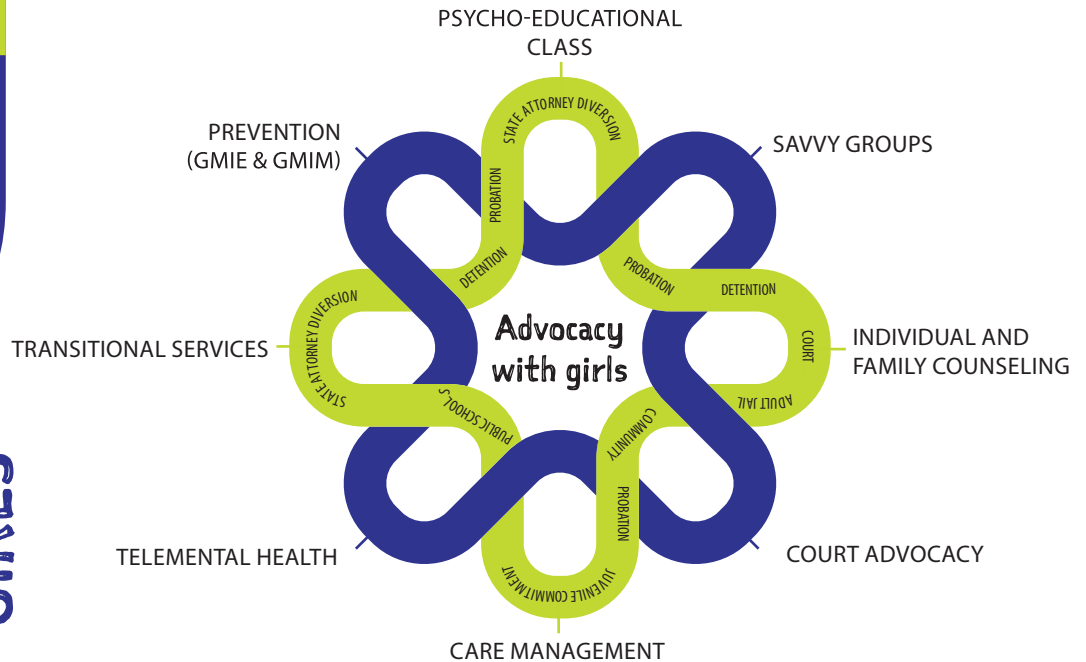

The relationships the girls build with the staff follow her throughout the system.



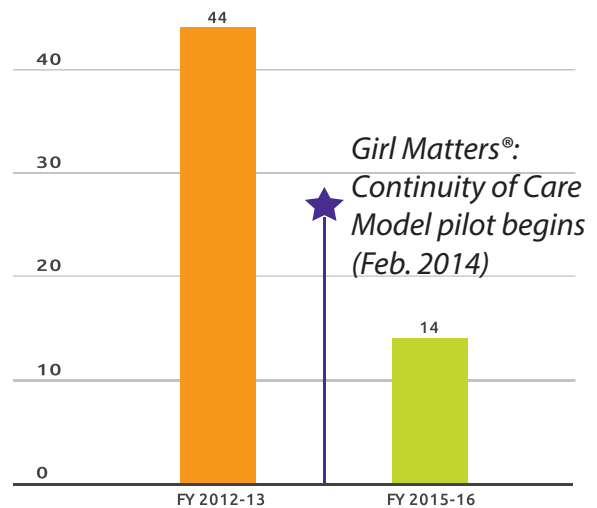

67% reduction for girls' incarceration in Duval County since the Policy Center opened in 2013, compared to 27% statewide for girls.
