

APPLY FOR A RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

Joan Amery Van Vleck Fellowship

This one year practicum experience equips the fellow with research and advocacy skills. Fellows increase their understanding of how research, advocacy, training, and girl-centered, trauma informed intervention services are related to improving system responses to girls and young women. Research Fellows play a key role on the Policy Center team by engaging in research activities and projects.



FELLOWS WILL:

- Collect data and perform data entry on multiple data collection projects
- Conduct preliminary data analysis including qualitative data coding
- Develop and build resource libraries including measures and assessment tools library
- Conduct literature reviews and provide assistance with drafting position statements
- Develop support materials for research and evaluation
- Provide overall administrative project support

Time commitment of this Fellowship is approximately 15 hours/week for one year. Fellow will receive a \$3,000 stipend upon successful completion of fellowship requirements.
